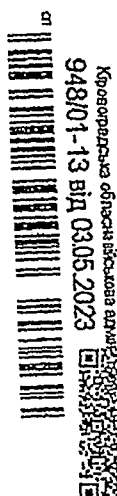

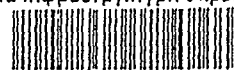

Heads of military administration districts,

'Access Israel' is a non-profit that promotes accessibility and inclusion for people with disabilities and the elderly in all areas of life. 'Access Israel' has created top-quality practical trainings, E-learning resources, videos, tutorials, courses, and seminars that offer practical tools to effectively implement and integrate accessibility. Our belief is that providing high-quality and significant training on accessibility awareness, along with practical experiences, is essential to successfully integrate individuals with disabilities into society. The key to achieving this success lies in changing attitudes and providing professional knowledge on individuals with disabilities.

In March 2022, When the war broke out in Ukraine, and requests for assistance started to come, 'Access Israel' recognized the need to ensure that solutions on the ground were accessible for people with disabilities and the elderly. 'Access Israel' has initiated the 'Purple Vest Mission', an initiative to promote accessibility readiness during times of emergency for people with disabilities and the elderly. 'Purple Vest Mission' focuses on training individuals and groups on the ground to provide accessible assistance and evacuation specifically for people with disabilities, the elderly, and their families. During 2022 we managed to evacuate almost 4,000 people with disabilities, elderly and their families and assist over 10,000 people with humanitarian aid.

As part of the cooperation that has formed with Ms. Tatiana Lomakina, Adviser, President Commissioner on barrier-free society issues, we are honored to invite regional accessibility coordinators from Ukraine to professional training on topic "Accessibility and Inclusion for all" with a focus on readiness during times of emergency for people with disabilities and the elderly. The activity will take place in Krakow, Poland between May 17- 20, 2023. And will be sponsored my MFA Israel.

All sessions will be conducted in English with translation to Ukrainian.

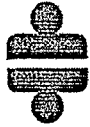


we are honored to invite regional accessibility coordinators from Ukraine to professional training on topic "Accessibility and Inclusion for all" with a focus on readiness during times of emergency for people with disabilities and the elderly. The full list of participants is below. The activity will take place in Krakow, Poland between May 17- 20, 2023. And will be sponsored my MFA Israel.

Main goal of the training: Providing comprehensive professional knowledge and tools for integrating people with disabilities into society and promoting awareness to accessibility on the ground, as well as ensuring the readiness and effective response during emergency situations for all types of disabilities.

At the end of the training the group will get core comprehension of accessibility for PWD and the elderly, including main aspects of physical and service accessibility with an emphasis on accessibility in times of emergency, and they will experience different disabilities themselves in order to experience first-hand the challenges of accessibility. The group will be able to analyze and review accessibility barriers in the field, know how to approach and address a person with a disability, how to communicate when in need, understand better the needs of people with a disability and the best way to help them, and will be able to pass new knowledge and practices to other service providers.

First meeting with the group will be online as part of the preparation to the training and will take place on May 10th. The meeting will include an introduction to several individuals with disabilities who will share their personal stories, the challenges in dealing with the disability, the meaning of the disability in an emergency, the success stories, and tips on how to help PWD.
